From the Chairman—Tony Thompson

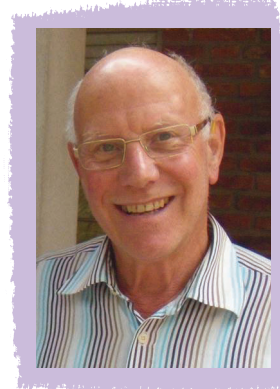

Colombia

On the border between Colombia and Venezuela, live members of the Wayuu indigenous people. They are the largest indigenous group in Colombia, and number some 400,000.

There are many small churches in that vast area, but most pastors have received very little Biblical training. So, three years ago, CIPEP Colombia under the able guidance of its director, Ubaldo Restán, started using SEAN courses to provide training for pastors and leaders amongst the Wayuu.

We praise God that now, over 150 Wayuu leaders, representing 12 different denominations, are faithfully studying a range of SEAN courses.

The Wayuu dialect is basically an oral language. So they use the Spanish study materials for their written work but, in their group meetings, prefer to discuss the lessons in their native tongue!

We appreciate them because they are:-

1. **Well written and very accessible for the average Christian, whilst also useful for the most educated.**
2. **Strategically planned so as to provide a process of discipleship, training, and equipping as students work through the various courses.**
3. **Balanced in their design, to foster individual participation along with group dynamics and community development.**
4. **Available and affordable.**
5. **Offered within a well-defined philosophy of education, and including a structured approach for the user.**
6. **Soundly based on the Scriptures and written by capable, mature Christian teachers, as evidenced by the material itself.**
7. **Mostly self-instructional, therefore groups can be led by a facilitator rather than by a teacher.**



All of my ministry years, I have longed to bring a 'Bible School' type ministry into the church.

SEAN has provided the opportunity to do so.

Our first **'Life of Christ'** group is now on Book Six. A second group is now working through Book Four. We have had good experience with **'The Big Picture'** (*Abundant Light/Pure Gold*), **'Abundant Life'**, **'How to Preach'**, and the **'Bible Encounter Manual'**.

I especially like the way that the SEAN courses allow me, as pastor, to quickly equip and mobilize other capable Christians to lead SEAN groups. The multiplication process is well under way for us!

So, please accept my sincere "thank you" for making SEAN available to us. God bless all the people that have had a hand in developing the SEAN materials and approach. It is too bad that SEAN is not better known here in Canada! Surely it would be beneficial to many more churches if they were aware of it and were willing to give it a try.

Botswana

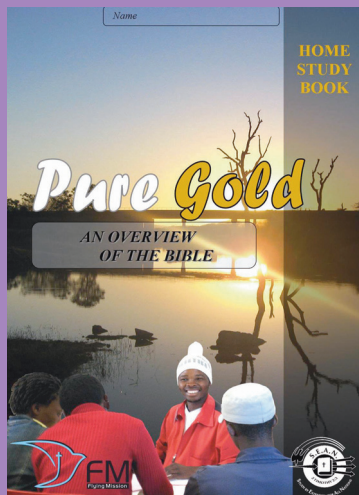


Six years ago, the Flying Mission, signed an Agreement with us for the use of SEAN Courses in Botswana in the English and

Setswana languages. We are delighted to have recently received the following news and other items from them.

Flying Mission greatly appreciates the use of SEAN materials. The discipleship programme that was set up some years ago continues to bear fruit in the local churches throughout Botswana. The Flying Mission provides training and supplies course materials. The churches then run the courses for their own members.

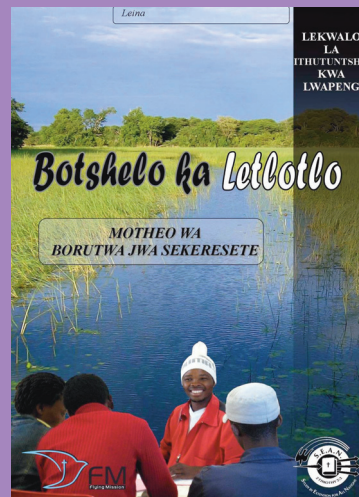
Currently there are 159 students led by 23 trained leaders studying **Life to the Full** and **Pure Gold**. Some use the English version others the Setswana version.



Pure Gold in the English language

Certificates are awarded to those who successfully complete the course, in recognition of their effort and achievement. The required standard for successfully completing the course is:

Students must have completed all the lessons in their Home Study Workbooks.



Life to the Full in the Setswana language

They must have attended at least 14 of the 18 group meetings. (80%)

All course workbook costs must be fully paid for.

Certificates are usually presented during the church's main meeting, which recognises those completing the course and promotes it to others. This can also be a good time for the graduates to give a brief testimony of what God has done in their lives through doing the course.

On 14th July, SEAN International celebrated its 42nd anniversary. From a small beginning in South America, in 1971, SEAN courses are now used in over 100 countries and 80 languages. We estimate that the number of courses printed and used now exceeds 1,500,000.

For SEAN to continue to meet the needs of the world-wide church in the 21st century, we need to restructure.
